Anna and Myer Russian Scholarship

Two scholarships will be given annually to graduating Windham High School seniors who have contributed unselfishly of time and talent to the Windham High School drama program and who plan to continue their education.

Brio Academy

Awarded to a student who is interested in a hairdressing career, of moral character and a pleasant personality.

Butleman Memorial Award

To the student with the highest rank in class.

Carl E. Gosline Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a well rounded, highly motivated student who plans to enter into the field of education.

Class of 1942 Memorial Award

Presented annually to the graduating senior who exemplifies the American ideals of patriotism, good citizenship, community interest and scholarship. Given in memory of the class of 1942, who gave their lives in world war ii in selfless sacrifice in loyalty to their country.

Class of 1952 Scholarship

Presented to a graduating senior with average grades, who exhibits leadership qualities, has shown growth and improvement while at WHS, has interest in the community and is furthering his/her education.

Class of 1955 Award, In Honor and Remembrance of Thomas R. Lawson (1917-2008)

Presented to a graduating senior who exemplifies high ethical standards, leadership abilities, respect for others, and service to school and community, participated in extra-curricular activities, has shown academic improvement in his/her high school career and plans to further their education.

Class of 1966 Scholarship

Presented to a graduating senior accepted to an accredited school of higher education (including a 1 year certificate program in a trade) and demonstrates good citizenship.

Class of 1967 Scholarship

Presented to a graduating senior who is planning on furthering his/her education. While a student at Windham High School, the recipient shall have exhibited leadership qualities, school/class spirit by participating in student group organizations and whose influence has strengthened the morale of the class.

Class of 1969 Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating senior who has exhibited exemplary school spirit

Class of 2002 Scholarship

Presented to a graduating senior who is involved in student government, has average grades and has participated in sports for at least one season every year. Student should exhibit leadership qualities and be respected by his/her peers.

Coach Bob Kazarian Student Athlete Scholarship

Student athlete, member of an athletic team, continuing their education. Alternate - male/female student. (Alternates male/female recipient) 2009-female

Coach Edward Ferrigno Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating senior who has excelled in the field of athletics, has been an inspiration to friends and teammates, and has gained the respect from all who know him/her.

Columbia PTO Scholarship

Presented by the Columbia PTO to a student from Columbia with top rank in class.

Columbia/Windham Columbus Day Soccer Tournament Award

Awarded to a student who will further his/her education, exhibit leadership and good character qualities and is involved in soccer.

Daniel R. Weaver Memorial Art Scholarship

Awarded to a student who is furthering his/her education and has a love of art.

Donald Berkowitz Memorial Scholarship

Awarded annually to a graduating senior who has been a member of a varsity athletic team for three years, has maintained a "B" academic average, and who plans to pursue a career in the field of education.

Donald R. Tuttle Scholarship

Awarded to a Columbia student, graduated from Horace W. Porter School, who is going on to an agricultural, technical vocational school, nursing or health related field.

Dr. Arthur and Harriet Buchbinder Scholarship

Awarded annually to a member of the national honor society with the highest rank in class.

Dr. Herman G. Pollack Science Award

Awarded annually to a graduating senior who plans to further his/her education in the field of science.

Dr. James T. Anderson Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating senior at Windham High School who has been accepted to an accredited institution of higher learning to further his/her education.

Dr. Stephen Emmett Owens Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating student who has contributed significantly to the performing arts at Windham High School and who plans to go on to further education.

Frederick W. Banning Memorial Scholarship

Awarded annually to a Windham Middle School student who is a graduating senior at Windham High School and who has demonstrated strong leadership, good character, and fine sportsmanship in the field of athletics.

Gager Prize

To a member of the senior class who shall have been a member of the school for at least three years and who shall be judged as having done the most for the school in the following ways: Participating in at least one branch of athletics, participating in other approved forms of activities, exemplifying high qualities of leadership and commendable ideals of living.

General Cable

Awarded annually to a senior who has participated in more than one extra-curricular activity, and who has made an outstanding contribution to the general welfare of the school, and who has exhibited good citizenship.

Good Citizenship Award – Ionic Lodge #110 Ancient Free & Accepted Masons

Outstanding academic effort, good behavior, community spirit, pursuing post secondary education, and strong character in times of adversity.

Guilford Smith Memorial Library Association Scholarship

Presented to a graduating senior, preferably from south Windham, who is planning to major in library science. If there is no one planning to major in library science, the award will be presented to the highest ranking student from south Windham.

Hochberg Memorial Scholarship

To be awarded annually to a Windham High School graduate who has been accepted in a college and is pursuing a pre-medical course of study.

J. Zalmon Hunt Award

To be awarded annually to a graduate of Windham High School who is an outstanding school citizen and has exhibited superior achievement in history.

James V. Sullivan Scholarship Award

Presented in memory of the late James V. Sullivan, Assistant Superintendent of the Windham Public Schools, to a Windham High School student who has made outstanding contributions of time, energy and personal commitment to promoting the betterment of the school

Jason Marc Metivier Memorial Scholarship

Awarded annually to a graduating senior who has participated in athletics, has shown growth and improvement during his/her stay at Windham High School, plans to attend a four year college, with the potential to succeed and has made high school fun for all who knew him/her.

Jennifer Fox Memorial Scholarship

Awarded annually to a four-year college bound senior involved in co-curricular activities who displays enthusiasm in all pursuits and is respected by the Windham High School community.

Jennifer Lynn Riquier Memorial Scholarship

Presented annually to a Windham High School graduate planning to attend college who has excelled academically, is active in student government, and is an exemplary role model for his/her classmates.

Joey Dumouchel DECA Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating senior, attending a 4 year college or university, honor student, an active DECA member for 2 or more years. (3 letters of recommendation required & essay – see Ms. King)

John Brian Crudden Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating senior who through academic achievement, participation in athletics and leadership ability has represented Windham High School in an exceptional manner.

John d. Welch award

Awarded for excellence in scholarship and service. (5 awards offered)

John F. Root, Jr. Foundation Scholarship

Presented to a graduating student who has maintained above average grades, has demonstrated an interest in science, having taken at least three years of science at Windham High School., has participated in at least one athletic sport each year and exhibits concern for others.

John Green and Peter Haddad Scholarship

Awarded annually to a graduate who has participated in a varsity sport, maintained a “B” average or better, demonstrated community service/volunteerism and is planning to attend an accredited 2 or 4 year institution of higher learning.

John Joseph Spillane, Sr. Scholarship

Presented annually to a graduating senior who has demonstrated superior academic achievement and outstanding school citizenship and who is planning to continue in a business related field.

John Kowalski Memorial Scholarship

Presented to a student in the graduating class who is going on to college to prepare for a teaching/coaching career.

Kathleen Nebus Speranza Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a senior who is caring and has good ethical standards, has demonstrated good citizenship and who has had significant academic improvement during his or her high school career.

Laurence King Scholarship Award

Awarded to a member of the Windham High School graduating class who has exhibited service to class and school during three years at Windham High School, excellent citizenship, growth in leadership abilities, and continual improvement in scholastic standing.

Lauter Greer Flanzer Achievement Awards

Awarded to a student who resides in Windham/Willimantic, pursuing disciplines in performing arts or engineering and with good academic grades.

Lauter Greer Flanzer Foundation Scholarship

Awarded to a student attending the University of Connecticut on the basis of scholarship, citizenship, character, evidence of leadership, and financial assistance.

Lion Myron Berkowitz Award

Awarded to a graduating senior from Columbia who is continuing his or her education in an accredited institution of higher learning, has demonstrated leadership ability, and has shown an interest in community service and good citizenship.

Margaret Danehy Memorial Award

Presented to a Columbia student graduating from Windham High School and has been accepted to either a 3 or 4 year nursing program.

Mary I. Bujak Scholarship

Presented annually to an outstanding business education student who will continue his/her education in a business related field, English spoken as second language.

Republic Oil Award

To a student with exceptional scholastic achievement, wide intellectual interests and outstanding contributions to the school.

Tom Meikle Memorial Award

Founded by Thomas a Callaghan, former Director of Athletics in honor of Thomas Meikle

Given to a senior class member who has excelled in athletics, who by example has been an inspiration to friends and teammates, is a school citizen of the first rank whose personal qualities have gained the respect of associates, and whose influence has strengthened the morale of our teams.

WFT Christa McAuliffe Scholarship

Awarded annually by the Windham Federation of Teachers to the highest ranking student in the graduating class who plans on entering the field of education.

Willimantic Firefighters Local 1033, Ralph A. Rodman Memorial Scholarship

Awarded annually to a graduating senior who has above average grades, accepted by a 2 or 4 yr accredited college, and active in the community.

Windham Firefighters Memorial Scholarship

Awarded annually to a student in good standing with b average, member of his/her family in the fire dept or a student going into the fire or medical field. (applicants should mention if a family member is associated with fire dept or volunteer)

Windham Food Service Employees Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating student who is furthering their education in management/food service, maintained above average grades and in consumer science.

Windham Middle School PTO Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating senior who is a graduate of the Windham Middle School, demonstrates academic accomplishment, exemplifies good citizenship and shows an appreciation for the diversity of the community.
