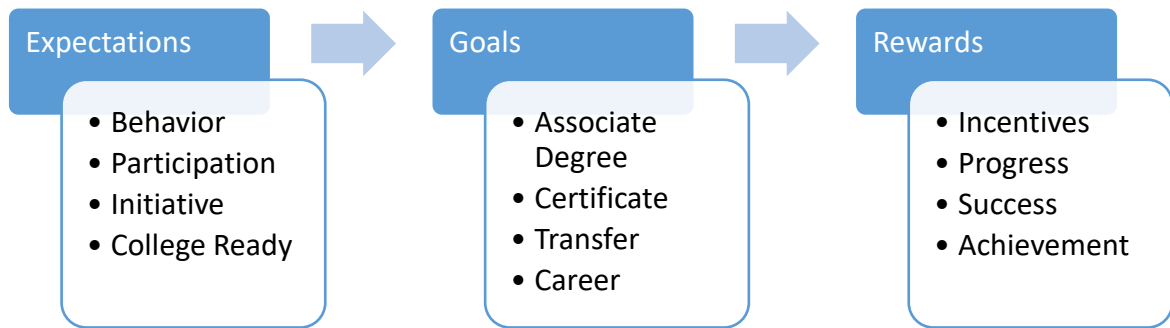


Beyond the Credits: Student Guide
