Other Information:

- a. Scholarship applications will be available at Post 181 beginning February 1st each year. Applications will be available at the high school guidance office or by contacting Colonel Crawford Post 181.
- b. The completed application must be submitted back to Post 181 or 4684 Stetzer Rd by <u>April 1st of the year applying.</u> The Scholarship Committee will consider each applicant's citizenship qualities, activities and character.
- c. We encourage all students who show qualities of good citizenship to apply for these scholarships.

Selecting the Scholarship Winners.

- a. The submitted scholarship applications will be reviewed by a committee comprised of the members of SAL 181. Winners will be selected no later than May 15th and notified on or about June 1st of the year of the application.
- b. After reviewing the applications, the members reviewing them will vote by secret ballot to select winners of the scholarships.
- c. Scholarships will be awarded to one male and female. In the event only one gender applies, or one does not meet the qualifications, the selection committee reserves the right to award both scholarships to two members of the same gender.
- d. The decisions made by the committee and the winners selected will be final.

Awards of the scholarship funds:

- a. The applicants selected to receive the scholarships must show proof of acceptance, enrollment and fees paid as a full-time student in a college or university by September 1st of the year of application.
- b. If an applicant selected to receive scholarship fails to enroll in a college/university by September 1st, or otherwise defaults, the scholarship will be awarded to the applicant selected next in order of placement.
- c. If a scholarship recipient withdraws from college/university during the school year following receipt of scholarship, any funds remaining from the award must be returned to SAL 181.

Disbursement of funds:

- a. Funds will be disbursed by check to the student for educational use and not to college.
- b. 50% of scholarship amount will be disbursed for the first semester of school upon tuition paid receipt.
- c. 50% will be disbursed the following semester upon receipt of a tuition paid receipt and grade transcript showing a 3.0 or higher GPA from fall semester
- d. Funds will be disbursed through the Sons of the American Legion Sq. 181.
